FA Charter Standard Health Check 2017/2018 - Guidance

In order for clubs to retain their FA Charter Standard status they must complete the Annual FA Charter Health Check.(AHC).

FA Charter Standard Health Check Window

Window Opens	1 st September 2017
Submission Date	1 st December 2017
FA Charter Standard Status Suspends	31 st March 2018

Benefits of the FA Charter Standard Annual Health Check

In addition to the The FAs notification, **annual communication from BBFA to inform FA Charter Standard clubs of their current status in relation to meeting FA Charter Standard criteria**

Support clubs in tracking the validity of their voluntary workforce

Provide clubs with online tools through the FA Whole Game System (WGS)

Allow clubs to allocate volunteers to their teams

Identify volunteer workforce within your club

Shows when awards expire

FA Whole Game System to assist club officials in administrating their club

AHC Requirements & Criteria

Clubs must comply with the following criteria in order to retain their FA Charter Standard status

1. All clubs must have a named coach with an up to date;
 - CRC
 - FA Emergency Aid
 - FA Safeguarding
 - Minimum of FAL1
 - Member of the FA Licensed Coaches Club (90%)
2. Assistant coach must have:
 - CRC

Promotion of the Annual Health Check will be released as of 1st September 2017 from The FA.

FA Charter Standard Health Check Checklist

- Club have until 1st December to submit their AHC
- All teams must have an assigned qualified coach with;
 - CRC
 - FA Emergency Aid
 - FA Safeguarding
 - Minimum of FAL1
 - Member of the FA Licensed Coaches Club
- All assistant coaches must have CRC in place
- Adult club must have minimum of FA Emergency Aid (in date)
- Adult club coach/s (CRC needed if 50% or more player under age of 18)
- No 'in progress' CRC accepted.
- Coaching qualifications accepted if proof of registration on a future course.

After AHC is approved:

- Clubs will receive notification from WGS and The FA
- Footballs and notification of confirmation form The FA
